basic services of funeral director and staff

Our fee for basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to:

- ◆ staff to respond to initial request for service, 24 hours a day;
- ◆ arrangement conference with family and responsible parties;
- ◆ planning the funeral;
- ◆ preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits;
- ◆ recording vital statistics;
- ◆ preparation and placement of obituary notice;
- ◆ coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., cemetery, crematory, vault companies, and others as required.

Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as regulatory fees, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, parking lot and grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping, and secretarial and administrative expenses.

This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.) Additional staff services required are detailed for each level of service..... \$1,385

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing or entombment. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. Washington State law requires that within 24 hours of receipt of the remains, the funeral home must either embalm or refrigerate until final disposition. (RCW 18.39.215)

direct cremation - with no ceremonies

The charge for a direct cremation includes: 1) basic services of the staff and obtaining the necessary authorizations, 2) removal/transfer of remains, 3) temporary preservation/refrigeration, 4) placement of remains into cremation container, 5) cremation process. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The container we offer is a cardboard box.

- 1. Direct cremation with cremation container provided by the purchaser ... \$ 1,455

- 2. Direct cremation with a cardboard box (plus tax)..... \$ 1,550

immediate burial - with no ceremonies

The charge for immediate burial (without ceremony or viewing) includes: 1) basic services of staff and obtaining the necessary authorizations, 2) removal/transfer of the remains, 3) temporary preservation/refrigeration, 4) placement of remains into casket 5) transportation to cemetery within a 30-mile radius.

chapel rental \$ 1,385

It is also utilized when another funeral home rents the use of our facility for a service. Included in this charge are: 1) Basic services of funeral director and staff, coordination of service, and assistance with chapel equipment 2) facilities charge for a funeral or memorial service in our chapel. All accommodation items, such as clergy, organist and soloist and newspaper notices, are additional.

forwarding of remains to another funeral home

- (No local service): \$2,345
- This charge includes: basic services of staff and obtaining necessary authorizations, local removal/transfer of remains, embalming, placement of remains into transportation container, combination air tray, local delivery to airport or common carrier. Charges for other services, merchandise, or use of facilities will be detailed elsewhere. This charge does not include additional mileage, shipping charges, consulate fees, casket, visitation, rites or ceremonies or Washington State sales tax, prior to forwarding of the remains.

receiving remains from another funeral home
